

Post-Secondary and Transcript Information

Student Services is an excellent resource and is well equipped to assist students and their families in the exploration of post-secondary programs. Programs guides with faculty information and admission requirements from several institutions across the province and the country are available and counsellors are happy to help with the applications process and related details.

Post-Secondary Information:

University of Alberta: Applications open Oct. 1st; deadline is May 1st

MacEwan: Applications open Oct. 1st; programs close periodically throughout the following year based on available seats, etc.

Nait: Applications open Oct. 1st; overprescribed programs deadline is March 31st

Concordia: Applications open Oct. 1st; June 30th deadline

Kings: Applications open Oct. 1st; late deadline

Check School Zone and listen to the Daily Bulletin for information about post-secondary schoolsvisiting Strathcona. Presentations are generally hosted at lunch in Student Services.

Application to most post-secondary institutions is completed online through **Apply Alberta**.

Out of province: Apply before Christmas as most deadlines are Feb. 28 or earlier.

**Check individual websites for deadlines. Assume an 85% min. average to go out of province and potentially higher if Science, Business or Engineering.

Courses for admission for all universities are posted on their website or printed in program guides; check thoroughly as changes occur year to year.

Transcript Information:

If you have applied to an Alberta institution through "Apply Alberta", you do not need to send official transcripts at the end of June; the Apply Alberta site will automatically send them.

Official transcripts for Post-Secondary Institutions outside of Alberta need to be requested from Alberta Education and are sent by Alberta Education after Diploma exams in June.
