RESULTS

Your grades should be similar, whether you're taking AP or not. Switching to a non-AP class does not guarantee a higher mark. Generally, Scona students do very well, in class and on their exams.



UNIVERSITY



You can receive credit at most post-secondary schools, depending on your AP exam result. You can also use your AP exam score for admission.

PREPARATION

The U of A recognizes 4 key skills students develop in AP:

- 1) Time management
- 2) Workload preparation
- 3) Exam writing skills
- 4) Perseverance



COMMITMENTS



Can you manage everything? You might make decisions based on balancing your commitments, but remember, to write the AP exam, you need to take the class.
